Significant Observations of Rules from the Referee Perspective	The rules used were the status quo, with one exception. This is the first PATU event where the IR did not stop the match to tell/jesture the players to fight. As in recent WTF Championships, the IR simply leaned closer to the players to make the fight jesture.
Canadian Results	Team Canada finished 2 <sup>nd</sup> overall, both the male and female teams also finished 2 <sup>nd</sup> . Yvette Yong received the Female MVP award and Jamie Dossantos received the Female Coach award.
Final Comments	4 USAT referees (one is an IR) were used to do weigh ins and inspection thereby freeing the IR's to work in their respective rings. The 4 were overseen by the PATU Referee Director and the PATU Tournament Director (who is also a current IR). This was a very helpful method of assisting the IR's.
